- Move-ups/Transfers will be allowed for the rally trials. All move-ups must be in writing (email is acceptable) and given to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- All classes requiring jumps will be arranged in jump height order. Judging
 will begin with the 4 inch jump height and continue in ascending order. If
 you are entering any of these classes jump height is a required part of
 your entry. Please refer to AKC Rally Regulations for the description of
 classes, eligibility, and proper jump heights. Exceptions may be made for
 handlers with multiple entries.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases. Proof of rabies and other vaccinations should be available on request.
- Entries will not be accepted without proper form, fees, and signatures. Please type or print legibly. Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information on entry forms. After the published closing date, no entry fee will be refunded in the event of errors, omissions, or cancellations. There will be no refund for duplicate entries.
- Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. Accounts or with International Money Orders in U.S. funds.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Trial Secretary
 will be obligated to call or notify exhibitors of when they are due in the
 ring for judging. Judges are not required to wait for any dog.
- RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
