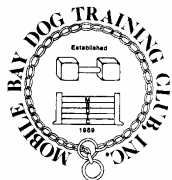

RUNNING ORDER

Running order is: Tall to Small each day.

Ring 1 Fast (Friday) and Standard Classes **Ring 2** Time2 Beat and Jumpers With Weaves Classes. Alternating rings. **Only one ring will be running at a time.**

Friday and Saturday: Excellent Fast, Open Fast, Novice Fast, followed by Time 2 Beat, Excellent Standard, Excellent JWW, Open Standard, Open JWW, Novice Standard, Novice JWW.

Sunday: Excellent Standard, Excellent JWW, Open Standard, Open JWW, Novice Standard, Novice JWW.

Judging will begin at 8:00 Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Briefing will be at 7:45 a.m.

Friday, Saturday & Sunday. Trial site open each day at 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Measuring times will be at judge's discretion.

ENTRIES and FEES

\$23.00 for the first entry and **\$10.00** for each additional entry of same dog each day (includes AKC recording fee of \$3.50 for first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog). Mail entries on official AKC entry forms and entry fees to MBDTc, c/o Winona Leard, Trial Secretary, 61 Hillside Lane, Mobile, AL 36608. **MAKE SURE SIGNATURE IS NOT REQUIRED FOR EXPRESS ENTRIES.** For limited trials, entries for a maximum of ten dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary. The limit also applies to the number of dogs entered per online transaction. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than 10 dogs shall be treated as an invalid entry and returned to sender. Entries must be legible. Entries are accepted on a First Received basis at the address of the trial secretary. No hand deliveries will be accepted during the first 24 hours after the trial opens. Email confirmations will be sent, please make sure any spam blockers are set to accept email from nonaleard@comcast.net. **You can now enter via AKC's Online Entry Services.** www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow instructions to use your My AKC account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, 150 entries will be accepted from online entries and 180 from mail in entries for each day.

ENTRIES. Entry Forms **MUST** be filled out completely. Incomplete entries do not constitute a valid entry. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and, no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the form are not acceptable. Unsigned Entry forms cannot be accepted, or entries that specify any conditions as to their acceptance. **PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE CLEARLY. PLEASE ENSURE EMAIL ADDRESS IS LEGIBLE.**

Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after the Closing Date/Time:

MBDTc is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 30 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to January 25, 2012 @ 6:00 p.m.. Any entries withdrawn that are received by January 30, 2012 @ 6:00 p.m. will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Monday January 30, 2012 @ 6:00 p.m. will receive a full refund.

NOTICE: This Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded to dogs with qualifying scores. A MBDTc bag or dog water bowl will be awarded to each exhibitor. MACH and PACH bars and MACH and PACH ribbons will be awarded to dogs completing MACH or PACH requirements during the trials.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. A warm up area with a regulation agility jump will be provided. **Weave poles will have 24" spacing. Contact equipment will be rubberized.**

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARDS

All dogs competing in AKC Agility must present a valid official AKC Jump Height Card prior to running. If your dog does not have a card, (or if a temporary card has expired), you **must** have your dog measured prior to running any course, except dogs in the 24"/26" class. If an AKC rep or a VMO is present, then all dogs without height cards must be measured before running.

PLEASE NOTE NEW AKC POLICY ON HEIGHT CARDS

JUMP HEIGHT CARDS ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED WITH THE ENTRY FORM. THE ENTRY FORM HAS BEEN CHANGED SO THAT YOU ONLY NEED PLACE A CHECKMARK IF THE DOG NEEDS TO BE MEASURED. IF YOUR DOG NEEDS TO BE MEASURED, IT IS THE HANDLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THAT THE BOX ON THE ENTRY FORM IS CHECKED AND THAT THE DOG IS MEASURED PRIOR TO RUNNING.

MOVE UPS

The Trial Secretary must receive move ups by 6:00 p.m. CST Monday, February 6, 2012. Day to day move ups due to legs earned at these trials will be accepted until the conclusion of awards on the day prior to each trial. Move ups from Novice A to Novice B after closing are not permitted per AKC rules. Move ups may be emailed to nonaleard@comcast.net or mail to the Trial Secretary.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." *By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.* These trials are open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register able breeds that have AKC PAL/ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the "Registration and Discipline Rules" for the listing of register able breeds that may participate. Proof of rabies and other vaccinations should be available upon request. Exhibitors and/or handlers are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height classification. Handlers may opt to run in a higher division, but not a lower height than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred Class must jump the specified height.

TRIAL REGULATIONS

Entries must be made on official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the Agreement and Rules. All entry forms must be signed and information must be legible.

Unsigned entry forms do not constitute a valid entry.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance. Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted after the entries have closed, except as provided in the Agility Regulations (Chapter I, section 13) and Rules Applying to Dog Shows (Chapter II, section 5).

Owners are responsible for all errors made in completing the entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such error or cancellation of entry after the closing date. Please write legibly on entry forms and include all necessary information.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from the competition by the action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area.

NOTE: Refund of entry fees (less \$5.00/day) for bitches entered that come in season after closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Trial Secretary. This certificate must be postmarked before the opening day of the show or given to the Trial Secretary before the start of the show.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$15.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the exhibitor will result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

*****Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.**

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS. PLEASE HELP KEEP THE TRIAL SITE AND HOTELS CLEAN.

Directions to Trial Site

From I-10 West, to Exit 13, Theodore Dawes. Drive North (left) approximately 11 miles, Note that you will be on Theodore-Dawes Rd, but 1.9 miles after you get off I-10, Theodore-Dawes Rd will become Schillinger Rd. Continue on Schillinger Rd. to the Archer Pavilion on the right. 1070 Schillinger Rd. N, 36608. (Irby Overton Vet Clinic will be across the street from the Pavilion. The Pavilion sits back from the road.)

From I-10 East, Take Exit I-65 North

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
